#### Risk of performing:

#### Risk of not performing:

The Agency will continue to experience significant challenges in performing its obligations. Specifically, the Agency will struggle to retrieve content associated with records, such as applications, evidence, notices, and decisions. This will hamper or entirely prevent the Agency from creating official Board records in the event of appeal, fully responding to KORA requests, and responding to other requests for information from parties or interested individuals. It also increases the administrative overhead incurred during content capture. Without new system the Board faces potential loss of meta data associated with not indexing files to LawBase records. Ultimately the longer the Board goes without a dedicated content management solution, the greater the cumulative toll of not having one will be, and the increased chances of data loss occurring.
